

E.O. "Red" Bowers

Inducted 1992

E.O. "Red" Bowers first registered ATA targets in 1971 and at the end of the 1991 target year, has registered 74,450 Singles, 65,000 Handicap and 45,000 Doubles targets for a total of 184,450 registered targets.

During the 1970's, Red served on the Board of Directors of the Tucson Trap & Skeet Club and during the 1980's, he served on the Board of Directors of the ASTA, including two years as Secretary/Treasurer and one year as Vice President.

In addition, Red served as the ATA State Delegate 1984 as well as several years as the Alternate Delegate.

In 1988, he won the Arizona State Doubles Champions with a then, record score of 99. He was selected as a member of the Arizona State Trapshooting Team for the years of 1980, 81, 84, 85 and 1987. In 1987, Red registered the first and only 100 straight in doubles at the Black Canyon Trap & Skeet Club, followed by a 99 the next day.

Red has received 100 straight pins from every trap club in Arizona with the exception of Pleasant Valley and Bullhead City, plus 100 straight pins from Minot, ND, Anchorage, AK and Truth or Consequences, NM. He won the Glenn Harrison Memorial Trophy at the Tucson T&S Club for the years 1977, 1980, 1981 and 1983. He also won the President's trophy at the Tucson T&S Club awarded for the high single and handicap scores for the combined Spring and Fall Festival Shoots for the years 1987 and 1988.

Mr. Bowers won the out of state championships for Singles and Doubles and tied for handicap at the 1988 Hawaii Shoot in Hilo.

He has won numerous trophies for singles, handicap doubles and high over all at various clubs throughout Arizona in addition to being the winner of the first John Schwartz memorial trophy at Nogales, AZ for the HOA in 1980.
