

Scott McClelland
Inducted November 30, 2013

Scott McClelland, our 47th Enshrinee, was born in a small farming community in West Central Iowa in 1959. He was introduced to hunting and shooting by his brother Mike, and family friends. Scott shot his first clay target at a gun club near Manson, IA when he was 11 years old, using a borrowed L.C. Smith 20 guage. A year later, he received a Winchester single shot 20 guage and a "Lee Load All" for Christmas. He became very proficient with the loading tools, even checking wad pressure with the bathroom scale!

Shooting opportunities were scarce while in school and when Scott went off to college; classes, work and the freedom of being away from home were his top priorities.

While away at school, Scott and Lynn met and started their life together moving to Tucson in 1979. In 1983, Mike put a shotgun back in Scott's hands and they started shooting a few targets at the Tucson Trap & Skeet Club and registered birds soon followed. That same year, Tiffany was born and in 1986, Stephanie came along. Both girls took some of their first steps on the front patio at TTSC.

Scott worked as a mechanic in a couple of dealerships in Tucson before starting with the Tucson Unified School District as a heavy equipment mechanic. His career there had spanned more than 30 years before he retired as a Transportation Facility Manager.

2013 marks Scott's 30th year of ATA competition that includes an impressive number of titles and, as of this writing, 206,250 registered targets. His service to the sport has been given freely, both locally and at the State level. He is in his 12th year of serving on the ASTA Board of Directors, currently as Vice President and also held the position of Secretary for two years. Additionally, Scott has served on the Board of Directors of the Tucson Trap & Skeet Club since 2008 and has held the positions of Secretary and Trap Chairperson. If you have had the good fortune to be in a shoot-off at the Tucson Trap & Skeet Club, you will see Scott not only busy working the shootoffs, but in many cases, rushing off to be in one!

Scott's impressive shooting record, his devotion and tireless service to the sport, make him most deserving of this highest recognition.

We welcome Scott to the Arizona Trapshooting Hall of Fame.
