**Call to Order:** President Mane called the meeting to order at approximately 4:35 PM. ### **Delegate Report**

They would like to have monthly AIM events and Zone AIM events, leading up to more AIM teams participating at the Grand American. Director Lockett commented on the recent two-yard reduction offered to all eligible ATA members, indicating the program had been well received. He also commented on the new categories added to all ATA shoots that carry All American points and indicated the shooters seemed receptive to the new categories.
