**Call to Order:** President Mane called the meeting to order at 4:39PM.

President Mane opened the meeting thanking everyone for attending and thanking the Tucson Trap & Skeet Club for the great job they are doing. He then asked for approval of the 2008 Annual Meeting Minutes, posted on the bulletin board.

**Motion to accept by Jim Grider, seconded by Scott McClelland,** motion passes by show of hands.

**New or Old Business:** No new or old business brought forward by the membership.

**President Mane then asked for Zone Director Nominations:**

**Zone A Nominations:** Ted TenBroeck nominated Betty Sackett, seconded by Walt Venberg. There being no further nominations, the nominations were closed.

**Zone B Nominations:** Rod Ritter nominated Art Nash. When asked for a second, a member informed the board that according to Robert's Rules of Order, a second is not necessary. Scott McClelland nominated Michael Braegelmann. There being no further nominations, the nominations were closed.

**Zone C Nominations:** Raylene Junkins nominated George Miller. Richard Loyd nominated Jim Grider. There being further nominations, the nominations were closed.

**Delegates Report:** **Doug Hawkins** reported on ATA business: The ATA has hired an Executive Director, Jim Thompson, a shooter and a businessman. The ATA has formed a youth program, AIM and Arizona is seeking a state director for that program. The AIM Committee is currently seeking a fundraising chairperson. Doug reminded everyone that Arizona will have a Western Zone site in Sierra Vista, hosted by the Garden Canyon Gun Club. He further encouraged everyone to attend the Western Zone shoot at the Garden Canyon Trap Club if at all possible.

**ATA Delegate Nominations:** Paul Doetsch nominated Doug Hawkins. Gene Hapney nominated Rod Ritter, seconded by Roger Junkins. There being no further nominations for Delegate, the nominations were closed.

President Mane asked the delegate candidates if they would like to say a few words.

**Rod Ritter:** Rod has been a long time trapshooter. Has shot all across the US, has been involved on the BOD and runs the Garden Canyon Trap Club in Sierra Vista. Rod would attend all shoots that he can in the state and will shoot at every single AZ club at least once during the year.

**Doug Hawkins:** Has been a trap shooter in the state since 1970, was a board member for 12 years including President three times, has served as Delegate for the past 11 years and the past two years served as the WN Zone Vice President. Has represented the state and continues to do everything he can to see that trapshooting prospers in the state. He has shot approximately 380,000 in the state of AZ.

**Alternate Delegate Nominations:** Doug Hawkins nominated Tim Robb. There being no further nominations, the nominations were closed.

### State Team Recognition

President Mane proceeded with recognition of the 2008 Arizona State Teams and High Average Leaders. Steve Neumann was recognized as shooting the Most Registered Targets - 23,150, with a plaque donated by Delegate Hawkins.
