### **AGENDA**

Election of Officer's

President Mane called the meeting to order at 8:50AM and welcomed Scotty McClelland to the board. He then called for the election of officers.

### **President:**

### **Vice President:**

### **Discussion**

President Mane asked the directors to send him any critiques of the state shoot at Ben Avery i.e., the food situation (only one vendor).

The date for the shoot date scheduling was discussed. Director Robb suggested April 30 for the meeting and also mentioned he had invited Steve Carmichael to attend so we could avoid any major conflicts with the Clark County Shooting Facility. All will check calendars and be notified accordingly.

Director Long mentioned that some of the winter chain visitors had expressed an interest in a two week rotation between the clubs versus one week due to the high cost of fuel. This concept will be considered, however, it may not be viable for the various clubs, especially those with multiple disciplines/activities.

Director Miller asked if the date conflict still existed for the World Cup scheduled at Tucson during the same time as the 2012 AZ State Shoot, which is also scheduled to be held at Tucson. Director Sims commented that no decision has been made by the ISSF to change the Cairo World Cup dates in order to accommodate different dates for Tucson. The dates for the World Club at Tucson are currently set for March 23 – April 1. Director Sims said he would have a firm decision on the World Cup dates at Tucson at the scheduling meeting.

Director Miller made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Tim Robb.
