A motion was made by Doug Sims to approve the Meeting Minutes of 2/26/15 posted on the Web Page. Motion was seconded by Richard Lane. Vote was 7 in favor 1 abstained ; Mark Williams. The vote passed.

The Secretary/Treasurer gave the Treasurer's report and informed the BOD of a total of \$174,282.61 in the bank.

A motion was made at this time by Mark Williams to approve these dates for the State Shoot and it was seconded by Steve Long. Vote was unanimous.

During the Pre Spring Grand and Pre Autumn Grand three Clubs will be throwing targets at the same time. The clubs are Ben Avery, Casa Grande and Tucson. All have agreed to this.

Hall of Fame Shoot was next on the agenda with two different months discussed. The months discussed were October and December 2015.

Mark Williams made a motion to hold the HOF Shoot the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of December each year and this was seconded by Al Matthews. The outcome of the vote was a deadlock 4 for and 4 against. Pro December were: Mark Williams, Karen Bergman, Al Matthews and Doug Sims. Against December were: Tim Robb, Ken Schatz, Steve Long, Richard Lane.

The BOD agreed to think about the dates for a few days and re-vote via a conference call which was set for May 6, 2015 at 7:00 pm. The outcome of this call will be posted as separate minutes under Conference Calls on the Web Page.

The Western Zone Shoot will be July 17,18, 19<sup>th</sup> of 2015. Discussion was held regarding classification and prizes to be given out at this shoot by the ASTA. Classification on 6 classes and 8 category prizes and Handicap Event 2 will be Champion thru 5<sup>th</sup> place. Doug Sims made a motion that we give \$50.00 for each winner of High All Around (400 targets) and \$75.00 for each winner of High Over All (700 targets). This motion was seconded by Mark Williams. Vote was unanimous. This money will be mailed to the shooters after the shoot by the Secretary/Treasurer.

Motion to end the meeting was made by Ken Schatz and seconded by Mark Williams. Vote was unanimous.
