

STATE TEAM REQUIREMENTS – Effective September 1, 2024 for future ASTA/ATA target years.

1. Candidates must shoot the three All-Around Arizona State Shoot Championship Events (400 targets) in the year under consideration.
2. Must shoot a minimum of three (3) different Arizona clubs. Note: The Arizona State Shoot qualifies as a separate club. Example: A person could shoot both a regular ATA registered event and the State Shoot at the same club hosting the State Shoot that year and it will count as two (2) clubs.
3. Your designated category will be your status on the last day of the ATA target year under consideration.
4. Target requirements remain the same.

Target Requirements:

Category	Singles	Handicap	Doubles
Men Open	2,000	2,000	1,000
Sub-Veteran	2,000	2,000	1,000
Women, Veteran, Sr. Veteran	1,500	1,000	500
Sub-Junior, Junior	500	300	200

Once these requirements are met, the top five (5) candidates with the highest composite averages, based on the registered targets shot during the preceding ATA target year, are selected for placement on each of the various teams.

The Delegate's 'Rookie of the Year' Award:

Shooters joining the ATA for the first time in the target year under consideration and who have shot a minimum of 500 singles, 300 handicap, and 200 doubles are eligible. The ASTA will also donate an ASTA Lifetime Membership to the winner.
